

Writing in books

Acceptable



Although written on, the writing has been confined to the outer edges of the page and thus is acceptable since we can trip this away. In fact, we can trim to the point where the arrow is indicating.

Acceptable

- Yellowing, Ink, or felt marks along the outer edges of the pages.

(We trim the pages of the books, up to the words, if necessary, on the outer three edges of the page.)

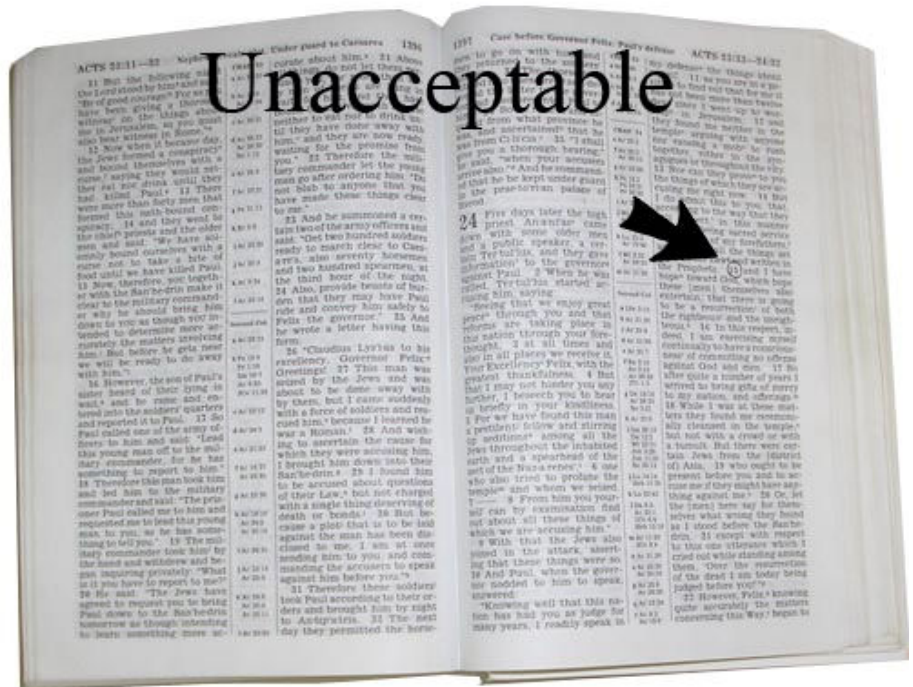
- Names or notes written on the white end sheets of the bible, or the maps.

(We replace these sheets in the binding process, so they do not matter if they are marked up or damaged)

Unacceptable

- Underlining, highlighting, or marks which are not along the outer edge of the page

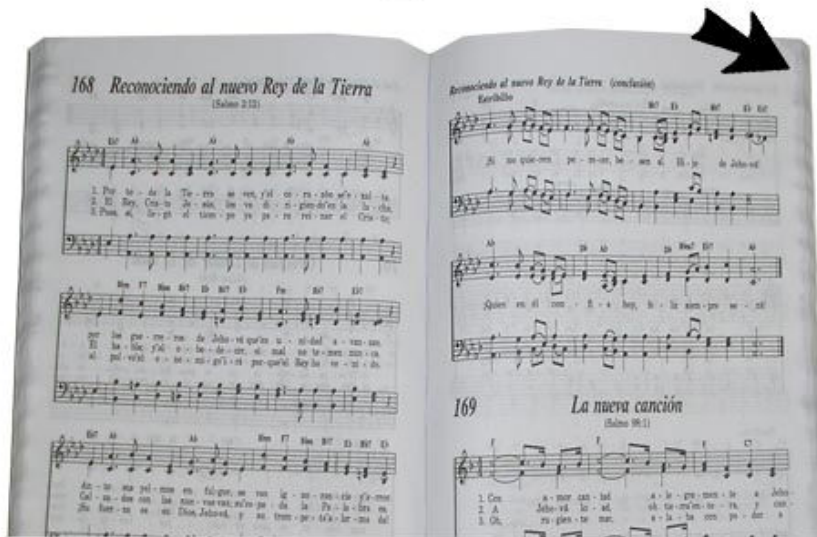
(We are unable to trip past the text of a book, doing so will cut off words or make them unreadable)



Though this book is in overall good condition, but we were unable to accept it for trade in due to pen marks within the body of the text on the pages. Unfortunately, even one such mark in a book will disqualify it.

Page Condition

Acceptable



The edges of this page have received water damage, but this is acceptable as it does not infringe upon the text or non trimmable area.

Acceptable

- A few turned or folded corners. (We can straighten out a few turned corners, but not too many, if these corners are not straightened before trimming, they stick out and detract from the finished product.)

- Water damage or slight wrinkling of the pages along the outer edges.

(We trim the pages of the books, up to the words, if necessary, on the outer three edges of the page.)

Unacceptable

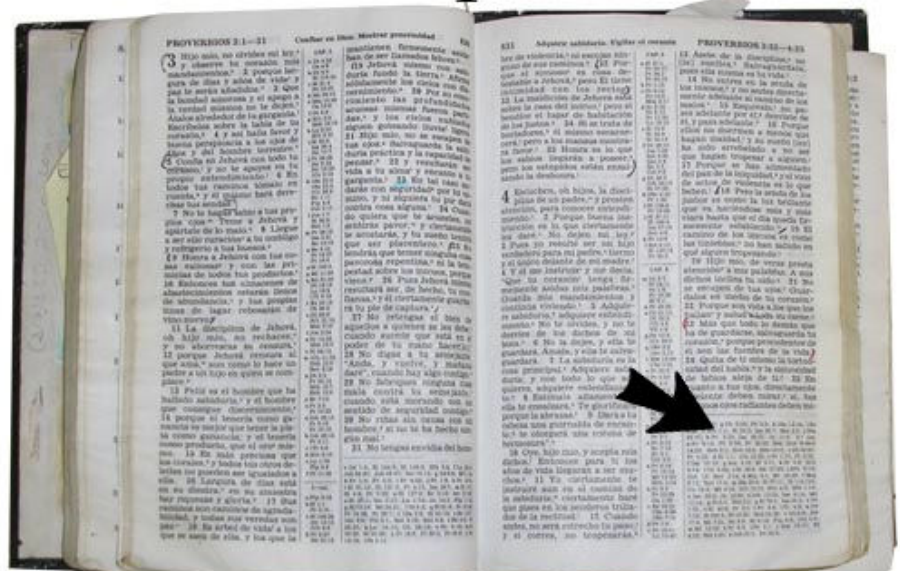
- Wrinkling or water damage that goes into the words of the book

(We are unable to trip past the text of a book, doing so will cut off words or make them unreadable)

- Many Corners folded or turned

(It can take over an hour to go through the book and find all of the corners. We have to go through the books several times to make sure that we don't miss any, and then unfold all the corners, and that is for just one book.)

Unacceptable



The overall condition of this Bible is unacceptable, but this page illustrates well unacceptable water damage well into the body of the page.

Overall Book Condition

We ultimately reserve the right to refuse ANY book that we feel is not acceptable. Should we do this, you may request to have the literature returned to you.

Acceptable



The book does not need its cover or end sheets to be intact or in good condition, We remove them anyways to make way for a new and better cover.

Acceptable

- The cover is falling off, but the inside pages are okay, End sheets falling off this way are also acceptable.

(We replace the cover and end sheets)

- The outer spine is separating from the binding, but the binding remains intact.

(We replace the spine as part of the cover, and rebind the book.)

Unacceptable

- Entire book is falling apart.
- Pages are missing
- Pages are damaged, torn or scuffed.
- Extensive water damage throughout the book
- Cover ripped taking chunks away from the page

(Overall, we are looking for a book in good condition, if you would not like reading this book, the same cannot be expected of anyone else.)

Unacceptable



This Bible is totally unacceptable, this picture illustrates on one page almost all criteria we have for denying a bible for trade in. It has ripped and torn pages, markings on pages, extensive water damage, missing oages, multiple dogears, and the binding is no longer intact. Should we receive a bible in this condition sent in for trade, we would have no choice but to deny it.
